Dear Parents and Community Members:

We are pleased to present you with the Annual Education Report (AER), which provides key information on the 2023-24 educational progress for Vestaburg High School. The AER addresses the complex reporting information required by federal and state laws. The school's report contains information about student assessment, accountability, and teacher quality. For the 2024-25 school year, schools were identified based on previous years' performance using definitions and labels as required in the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). A Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI) school is one that had at least one underperforming student subgroup in 2023-24. An Additional Targeted Support (ATS) school is one that had a student subgroup performing at the same level as the lowest 5% of all schools in the state in 2021-22. A Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI) school is one whose performance was in the lowest 5% of all schools in the state, had a graduation rate at or below 67%, or failed to exit ATS status in 2021-22. Some schools are not identified with any of these labels. In these cases, no label is given.

Our school was **NOT IDENTIFIED** by the Michigan Department of Education as needing Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI), Additional Targeted Support (ATS), or Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI).

Despite not being identified by the Michigan Department of Education (MDE) as requiring immediate support, our overall index score experienced a decline. In response, we have undertaken several proactive measures. These include:

- Adjusted student scheduling and assessment procedures.
- Introduced targeted interventions within the secondary school.
- Implemented a comprehensive K-12 Mathematics Curriculum, accompanied by monthly collaborative sessions for math teachers. These sessions focus on data analysis and the refinement of high-quality instructional strategies.

State law requires that we also report additional information.

1. Process for Assigning Students: Families are able to enroll their students in Vestaburg Middle/High School by coming to the office and completing the enrollment documents. Vestaburg Community School is a school-of-choice district, therefore out of district students would have to complete an additional application for approval.
2. Status of School Improvement Plan: Improvement is a continuous process at Vestaburg Middle/High School. Our [school improvement plan](#) is located on the MICIP Platform. It is monitored and updated by the school improvement and leadership teams.

### 7. Advanced course work participation data:

- Dual Enrollment: We're pleased to announce that 28 of our students are currently enrolled in dual enrollment courses. This program allows them to earn both high school and college credits simultaneously, giving them a head start on their collegiate journey while still in high school.
- Early College: Additionally, we have 5 students actively participating in the Early College program. This initiative enables students to immerse themselves in a college environment earlier than traditional pathways, fostering a smoother transition from high school to higher education.

While we provide robust opportunities through Dual Enrollment and Early College, we recognize the value of expanding our offerings to include courses that directly mirror college-level curriculum, providing students with even greater preparation for their academic futures.

The middle/high school staff participates in ongoing professional development to improve their skills with the goal of improving achievement for all Vestaburg secondary students. We are pleased to present you with the Annual Education Report (AER), which provides key information on the 2023-24 educational progress for Vestaburg High School. For the 2024-25 school year, schools were identified based on previous years' performance using definitions and labels as required in the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). A Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI) school is one that had at least one underperforming student subgroup in 2023-24. An Additional Targeted Support (ATS) school is one that had a student subgroup performing at the same level as the lowest 5% of all schools in the state in 2021-22. A Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI) school is one whose performance was in the lowest 5% of all schools in the state, had a graduation rate at or below 67%, or failed to exit ATS status in 2021-22. Some schools are not identified with any of these labels. In these cases, no label is given.

Our school was **NOT IDENTIFIED** by the Michigan Department of Education as needing Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI), Additional Targeted Support (ATS), or Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI).

Although our school is not identified by the Michigan Department of Education (MDE) as requiring immediate support, our overall state achievement data shows slow steady growth. In response, we have undertaken several proactive measures. These include:

- Improved PAWS (intervention) interventions
- Implemented intentional ELA and Math coaching
- Adopted new aligned, comprehensive Mathematics, ELA, and Social Studies Curriculum Programs.
- Required bi-weekly grade-level PLCs focusing on student data.

State law requires that we also report additional information.

1. **Process for Assigning Students:** Students or families wishing to enroll their students in Vestaburg Elementary School simply need to stop in the office and complete the necessary paperwork. They are a school-of-choice family. They would need to complete the SOC paperwork, get approved to enroll and complete the required electronic paperwork.
2. **Status of School Improvement Plan:** Improvement is a continuous process at Vestaburg Elementary School. The school improvement plan is located on the [MICIP Platform](#). It is

All curricula are aligned with the Michigan Core Curriculum. In addition, district personnel are transitioning to the Common Core State Standards for English Language Arts, Mathematics, and Literacy Standards for Social Studies and Science. VES's curriculum review/development process is ongoing, collaborative, and focused on horizontal and vertical K-12 alignment to ensure student content and process standards achievement.
5. Assessment - [2024-25 VCS Assessment Plan](#) / [Acadience Data](#)  
Vestaburg Elementary School implements the use of the NWEA Assessments to measure student growth. It is the goal for every VCS student to make a minimum of 1 year of academic growth, and using these assessments, this can now be measured. Students will take assessments in math and reading (3) times a year to measure their progress. Teachers will then use this to improve both the small group and the individual student instruction. Our challenges continue to fill the achievement gaps in reading and math; we are working on fixing those by placing all students in PAWS time. PAWS time is small group instruction for all students, filling the gaps or teaching advanced skills to those students who qualify.
